

Cyprus Driving Licence – Application Checklist

Use this checklist when applying for or exchanging a driving licence at the Cyprus Road Transport Department or a Citizen Service Centre.

- 1 Confirm you are eligible (valid licence, minimum age, and legal residence in Cyprus).
- 2 Ensure you have lived in Cyprus for at least 6 months (students must be enrolled full-time).
- 3 Obtain and complete Form TOM 7 (application form – in Greek).
- 4 Prepare your passport or Cyprus ID and photocopies.
- 5 Prepare proof of residence (utility bill, rental agreement, or bank statement).
- 6 If exchanging a licence, prepare the original licence plus photocopies of all pages.
- 7 If your licence is not in Greek or English, obtain an official certified translation.
- 8 Bring two passport-size photographs if not applying in person.
- 9 Prepare payment for the licence fee (approx. €40; free for applicants aged 65+).
- 10 Visit a Road Transport Department District Office or Citizen Service Centre.
- 11 Submit your documents and application at the counter.
- 12 Receive a temporary paper driving licence (if applicable).
- 13 Wait for your EU-format photo-card driving licence to be issued.

Important Notes:

- Licences for cars and motorcycles are usually valid for 15 years.
- Truck and bus categories are usually valid for 5 years.
- Medical certificates may be required for certain categories or ages.
- Keep copies of all submitted documents for your records.
